Dear Counselor and Prospective Student,

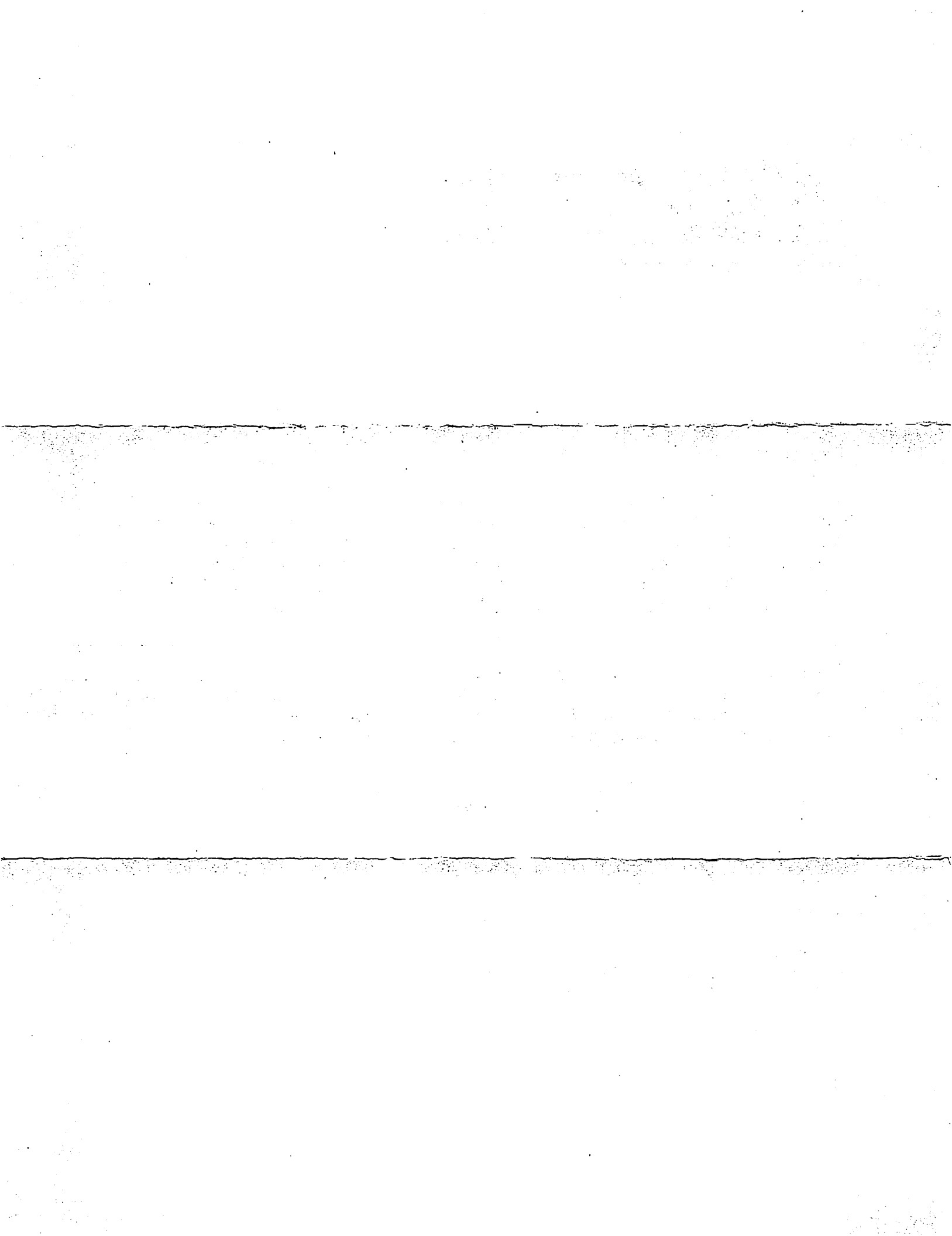
