I am pleased to announce that the Jefferson County School District has formed a partnership with The University of North Alabama. A scholarship has been established to increase the number of students enrolled in the field of education. This is most exciting, considering the number of college students who choose to pursue a career in education and the national teacher shortage. I applaud UNA for their efforts in addressing teacher recruitment and retention in the State of Alabama.

One LEAD Scholarship of \$10,000 per year for a period of 4 years (totaling 40,000) will be awarded to one graduating senior from our school district. The selected student must enroll at The University of North Alabama during the fall semester following high school graduation. In addition, the student must maintain an overall GPA of 3.25 and enroll in a minimum of 27 credit hours per academic year to remain eligible for the scholarship. This scholarship is not stackable with any other university scholarship. The scholarship winner will be announced on Friday, May 7, 2021.

The scholarship application is attached. If you know a graduating senior interested in applying for this scholarship, please forward them the application.
